

Brownstein Hyatt Farber Schreck Reports Federal Lobbying Revenues

Brownstein Hyatt Farber Schreck reported \$6,227,000 for its third-quarter federal lobbying revenues. This is a 10 percent increase over 2012 third quarter federal lobbying revenues.
