Prior to joining the firm, Moschella served as principal associate deputy attorney general for the Department of Justice. In his role, he was the principal legal and policy advisor to the deputy attorney general and provided advice on a range of issues including the department's role in the committee on foreign investment in the U.S., law enforcement and national security matters, and the general administration of the department. Prior to that, he served as assistant attorney general of the Office of Legislative Affairs until September 2006. Before that, Moschella served as the chief legislative counsel and parliamentarian to the House of the Judiciary, general counsel of the House Committee on Rules, and counsel to the House Committee on Government Reform. While at the Judiciary Committee, he served a key role in the passage of the USA PATRIOT Act and worked on numerous other important bills, including historic bankruptcy and class action litigation reform.

Rothman, a member of the firm's litigation group, focuses on complex commercial litigation in federal and state courts. Throughout her career, she has been involved in several significant cases, including the prosecution of business tort and mortgage fraud claims on behalf of a federally-insured financial institution victimized by a massive mortgage fraud scheme, the prosecution of patent infringement claims and the defense of fraud and conspiracy claims against a Fortune 500 investment bank.
