In an October 12 speech at the NYU School of Law last Friday, the head of the Department of Justice's (DOJ) Criminal Division announced a policy memo that sets forth the department's new process for the approval of corporate monitorship agreements and the selection of monitors. Benczkowski explained that the new policy follows a recent review of DOJ's corporate enforcement policies led by Deputy Attorney General Rod Rosenstein.
